Winemakers in Borderlands - At the far North East of Italy, close to Venice and at short walk from Cividale del Friuli at the border with Austria and Slovenia, Altùris vines benefit of an unique microclimate. The Julian Alps protect them from the cold winds of North, while the breezes from Adriatic Sea smooth and mitigate the climate, offering the vineyards exceptional conditions to produce grand quality wines.

Production

Guyot and Friuli single inverted. The grapes are gently desteemed before crushing. The must thus obtained is left to ferment together with the skins at controlled temperature with frequent pumping over in order to extract color and flavour. After racking, aging takes place in 500 litre oak barrels.

Tasting Notes

Intense ruby red with purple reflections. Delicate hints of plum, cherry, violets and black pepper, surrounded by pleasant cocoa sensations. The taste is pleasant, velvety on the palate with subtle tannins.
