Domaine Alain Aubert Chateau Ascension 2015

"Plenty and full, fresh modern and crisp"

A new estate is emerging on the Saint-Émilion plateau, among the foremost chateaux of this prestigious vintage. In the very heart of the thousand year-old vineyard, on the Saint Christophe des Bardes road, stands the Château Ascension whose fully-renovated buildingshave preserved the charm of the traditional rubble-stone, allied with the modernity of openings which provide a commanding view over carefully-tended vines. The half-buried cask storage cellar ensures optimum preservation of the wines.

Production

Vines are tended with loving care, and the selective, limited sorting of grapes is done intentionally. The wine storehouse is equipped with small-volume stainless steel vats and a new-generation thermoregulation system. Vinification is carried out via manual cap-punching and the wines are put in barrels by means of a gravitational system. The wine is aged 16 to 18 months in French oak casks.

Tasting Notes

A delight for the palate right from the start. The colour is intense and bright and the aroma has hints of red fruits. It is a full-bodied wine with tannin that will gain strength in time. Complex, well-balanced and deep, 2015-the first vintage of the Château-is a success.
