## Vineyards

The mythical mountains, Luberon to the south (1,125 m) and Ventoux to the North (1,912 m), forge the character of these appellations: maximum exposure to the sun, tempered by the altitude and the thermal amplitude thanks to the proximity of the Southern Alps, gentle slopes and limestone hillsides, rolling hills exposed to the benefits of the Mistral wind... All these factors favor the outstanding expression of this mosaic of terroirs Marrenon benefits from.

## **Production**

Harvest between mid-September and the end of October. Traditionnal vinification, including short vatting (15 days). Soft extraction of the grape-pomace and short ageing (15% of the wine) in French oak barrels.

## **Tasting Notes**

On the nose, intense aromas of black cherry jam and roasted nuts. In the mouth, light tannic structure, very pleasant and smooth with an explosion of fresh berries. This wine offers a lot of freshness and elegance with a finish on ripe dark cherry.
