VINEYARDS

Winemakers in Borderlands - At the far Northeast of Italy, close to Venice and at short walk from Cividale del Friuli at the border with Austria and Slovenia, Alturis vines benefit of a unique microclimate. The Julian Alps protects them from the cold winds of North, while the breezes from Adriatic Sea smooth and mitigate the climate, offering the vineyards exceptional conditions to produce grand quality wines.

WINEMAKING

Guyot and Friuli single inverted. The whole grapes are gently pressed to obtain the must followed by cold static decantation. Fermentation and aging take place “sur lies” in glass-lined cement tanks under controlled temperature.

TASTING NOTE

Intense straw yellow. A refined bouquet, broad and complex, with hints of tropical fruits, citrus, hay, bread crust and toasted almonds typical of this grape. The taste bears out the aromas and is intense, full, and fruity. A remarkable elegance and pleasantness.
