Terroir and more ...

VINEYARDS

With over 80 hectares of vineyards located in the most prestigious areas of rioja, they are spread out over six plots in the Cantabrian mountain range: Samaniego, Leza, Elciego, San Vicente de la Sonsierra, Laguardia and Abalos. In selecting these plots, careful consideration was given to the habitat, microclimate and orientation, as well as the low yield of the vines with an average age of fifty years.

WINEMAKING

Hand-picking and manual selection of grape from vineyards older than 60 years old, transport in boxes of 12kg and thermo regulated in specially designed cooling chamber during 24 hours (4-6 degrees) prior fermentation. Second selection of grapes on tables separating shoulders from tips. This wine is elaborated from destemmed shoulders. Fermentation in small stainless steel tanks.

TASTING NOTE

Bright light ruby color. Nose shows fresh strawberries, red plum and vibrant floral notes. The palate is fresh and has a firm structure with notes of spices balanced with the fruit.
