VINEYARDS

A selection of vineyards with more than 90 years is made considering differentiation of land as well as altitudes for the Tempranillo. And always harvested separately. _is type of vineyards assures us low productions, ideal for these elaborations.

WINEMAKING

Careful selection of bunches carried out in the manual harvest and subsequent vatting without the use of mechanical elements. Alcoholic fermentation in wooden vats and malolactic fermentation in new French oak barrels. Aged for 34 months in barrels.

TASTING NOTE

High intensity, intense purple red with cardinal hues. Great aromatic complexity with high initial intensity with very fine aromas dominated by fruity tones that gradually merge with the spices, tobacco and caramel typical of the aging as well as with balsamic and mineral touches. Very fine and complex aromas that evolve throughout the tasting. Fleshy, creamy, and unctuous wine. With a characteristic freshness that makes us recall the previously detected fruity tones in the aftertaste.
