Matarromera's most iconic wine

### VINEYARDS

Matarromera Pago de las Solanas is made from grapes from a specific and more premium area of 110 ha. The grapes have been chosen from this plot of the las Solanas vineyard for years, where a greater robustness highlights the finesse and potential of this limestone terroir, with a steep slope facing south close to 20%. The excellent sun exposure and its location in a specific narrowing of the Duero Valley, which concentrates the convection winds every day, makes this plot special, while a high hollow of deeper soil reveals and emphasizes its unique characteristics.

### WINEMAKING

Only the best areas of the fantastic and mythical las Solanas vineyards will see their Tempranillo grapes ripen, these grapes will then go on to be chosen and rigorously selected, one by one, to be part of Bodega Matarromera's most iconic wine. This exceptional and unique vineyard is the birthplace of the wine that proudly carries its name.

### TASTING NOTE

An exclusive wine, made only in perfectly developed vintages, to highlight the finesse of its special acidic black fruit notes from myrtle to ripe blackberry and its limestone and Indian ink minerality, subtly accompanied by spices and soft cocoa. Subject to measured aging in very fine grain French oak barrels, highlighting the terroir in its search for the balance of a wine with soul. Fine tannins on the palate, with an extraordinary length, elegance, and balance.
